


The house of Stamatis Kleanthis and Eduard Schaubert in Plaka, the first premises of the newly established University of Athens (1837-1842)

The University's Cultural Centre – Lounge (since 1985: "Kostis Palamas Building"). It was built in 1857 and, initially, it operated as a private Lyceum. In 1870, the building was purchased by the University of Athens in order to house Medical and Natural Science laboratories, lecture halls and University museums. In 1981, the building was renovated and, since then, it is being used as a Cultural Centre – Lounge, a Library and place for scientists' meetings.



The University of Athens and its branches (Athens 1923)


